

INTERNATIONAL COUNTRY MUSIC CONTEST "MAYFLOWER"

21-23 November 2017

Competition rules

- 1. The song contest is open to amateur solo vocalists at the age 10 19 who have not recorded any albums yet. Entrants cannot be signed to any record company.
- 2. The Organizer, the Youth Palace in Nowy Sacz, Poland, invites school students to take part in the vocal competition. There is age limit for the participants.

- 3. A school or a youth center is allowed to submit one entrant of each category after a careful selection.
- 4. Each entrant must perform one country song in English. The duration of the song must not be longer than 4 minutes.
- 5. The competition auditions will be held on **November 21**. They will start at **9 a.m.** at Aleje Wolności 23, Nowy Sącz, Poland.
- 6. The competition lists will be posted on its website: *palacmlodziezy.pl* on **17 November, 2017**.
- 7. The finalists will be announced on **November 23**, during the prize-winner concert. The Organizer will post all results on its website on **21 November**, **2017** at **10 p.m.** at the latest. Entrants are responsible for providing up-to-date and correct email addresses to the Organizer. They will be asked to sing the song they have performed at the auditions.

- 8. Failure to appear and perform the song at the prize-winner concert may result in disqualification and an alternate winner may be selected.
- 9. Entrants will be singing to background music they ought to bring with them (recorded either on a CD or a memory stick). They may use guitar accompaniment.
- 10. The Organizer will provide professional acoustic system and equipment reproducing sounds.
- 11. Entrants ought to fill in an entry form in English. All entries are due by **10 November, 2017**. Mail entries to: *dzial.imprez.pm@wp.pl* ("Mayflower") or Pałac Młodzieży, 33-300 Nowy Sącz, ul. Rynek 14, Poland.
- 12. The regular entry fee is 10 Euros per entrant paid on arrival.
- 13. The Jury will select the finalists and winners. The judging committee consists of high-profile music professionals. Songs are judged equally on melody, composition, originality, language (English) and lyrics. Entrants agree to accept the final decision of the judges.
- 14. Entry constitutes permission to use entrant's name, likeness, and voice for future advertising and publicity purposes without any compensation.
- 15. Entrants agree that should their songs be selected as a winner, the Organizer will have the right to include the songs on a compilation CD to be used for promotional purposes only. The CD will not be for sale.
- 16. By entering the competition, entrants and/or their parents or legal guardians (if such entrant is a minor) agree to accept and be bound by the decisions of the Organizer and their judges which are final and binding in all matters.
- 17. The winners will receive recognition via local media, awards and certificates signed by the Jury, President of Nowy Sącz, Director of the Youth Palace.
- 18. Entrants will pay travel-related costs if they choose to attend the festival. Food will be provided by the Organizer.
- 19. First, second and third place winners will perform at the prize-winner concert.
- 20. The Organizer reserves the right to extend the entry deadline and reduce entry fees.
